Commonly compounded formulations may include progesterone suppositories, nipple ointments, topical pain relievers, and more.

Progesterone Suppositories: Customized Support for Pregnancy

Progesterone plays a vital role in supporting a healthy pregnancy. Some healthcare providers prescribe vaginal progesterone suppositories as part of a care plan for women with specific needs, such as hormonal support or pregnancy maintenance. Compounded suppositories allow for tailored dosing and alternative formulations to meet individual preferences and sensitivities.

Postpartum Recovery: Addressing Common Challenges

The postpartum period, often referred to as the fourth trimester, can bring various physical and emotional changes. Compounding allows pharmacists to work with

providers to prepare customized medications that support:

- **Perineal healing:** Custom ointments may be formulated with ingredients like lidocaine, hydrocortisone, and antiseptics to help soothe discomfort.
- **Hormone balance:** Topical hormone creams can be compounded in personalized strengths and formulations.
- **Comfort and wellness:** Low-dose medications may be compounded when prescribed as part of a supportive care plan.

Postpartum Depression: Signs and Solutions

Many women experience "baby blues" shortly after childbirth, but if symptoms linger beyond a couple of weeks or grow more intense, it may be postpartum depression. You may be affected if you experience:

- Feelings of sadness, hopelessness, or guilt
- Difficulty sleeping, eating, or focusing
- Crying frequently without a clear reason
- Loss of interest in activities or your baby
- Thoughts of self-harm or harming your baby

If these sound familiar, know you are not alone, and that help is available.

What Could Be Causing It?

Postpartum depression is often linked to underlying imbalances such as:

- Low thyroid hormones (especially T3)
- Progesterone deficiency after childbirth
- Nutrient deficiencies (Vitamin D, B12, Zinc, Selenium, Omega-3s)
- Elevated copper or environmental toxins
- Autoimmune thyroiditis or Hashimoto's

Hormonal & Nutritional Support

Rather than masking symptoms, we take a holistic approach by helping you:

- Optimize thyroid and sex hormones (including bioidentical progesterone and T3)
- Replenish critical nutrients that support brain and mood health
- Support natural calming neurotransmitters like GABA through targeted hormone therapy
- Restore balance using lifestyle, nutritional, and personalized compounded therapies

Breastfeeding Support

Breastfeeding can be rewarding yet challenging. Compounded nipple ointments may include a combination of pain-relieving, antibacterial, and antifungal ingredients, designed to provide targeted relief while supporting continued nursing. Providers often request these formulations to avoid unnecessary additives sometimes found in commercial products.

Other Commonly Compounded Medications for Pregnancy & Postpartum

- Nausea & Morning Sickness: Custom formulations of doxylamine and pyridoxine may be prepared to help manage pregnancy-related nausea.
- Topical Pain Relief: Compounded creams with lidocaine, anti-inflammatories, or other ingredients may be used to support relief of localized pregnancy discomfort.
- Thyroid Support: Bioidentical thyroid hormone formulations can be compounded for precise dosing when prescribed.
